Sir,

With reference to the above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Govt. for establishment of Private Security Agency in the name and style "North Eastern Security Service" subject to strict observance of the following terms & conditions as outlined vide Addl. Director General of Police, (SB)'s letter No.SB.VIII/101/2001/SB/29966 dt.6.7.2000.

1. The registration of the security agency may be allowed only after the verification of the genuineness and authenticity of the Agency.
2. Verification of the C/A and the background of the individual or agency floating the security agency should be made compulsory.
3. The terms and conditions of the appointment of the security personnel for the Agency should be submitted to the Govt. which may be scrutinised by IGP(Security).
4. All the members of the security agency will be appointed only after the receipt of verification reports.
5. The photo identity card (PIC) to the members of the security agency must be issued by the private management after completion of verification by police.
6. Another danger to allow private security agency is the absorption of individuals of suspected nationality because of easy and cheap availability. It would be made obligatory for management to produce PIC/Citizenship certificates for all of the security personnel employed by them.

7. The Initial Police verification may not be considered as the final one. The system of police verification after every three years should be made obligatory for management of such agencies.
8. If at all weapons are to be issued to the security personnel of such agencies their arms training should be conducted directly under the control and supervision of Assam Police. The infrastructures for physical security of weapons should be made available as per standard norm to avoid the looting of weapons by the anti-socials.
9. The specification of uniform of private security personnel may be decided in advance to avoid any confusion with Assam Police. Under no circumstances such uniform should be allowed.
10. I.G.P., (Security) should constitute a committee to inspect the functioning of Private Security Agency to ensure that rules and guidelines stipulated by the Government are followed.
